

Charger Commitment Tuition Grant Application

The *Charger Commitment Tuition Grant* provides a tuition grant for continued Catholic educational opportunities for one incoming 7th or one incoming 8th grade student that currently attends Saint Charles and have registered for the 2021-22 school year. The maximum allowable grant will be equivalent to the tuition rate of one parishioner student. The primary goal is to provide short-term financial assistance to families that are committed to providing quality Catholic education to their children.

<u>The completed application packet must be received no later than March 1, 2021.</u> Please submit the packet to the attention of Mr. David Bogle. Packets may be dropped off in the Main Office or sent via US Mail to the school principal.

This is a one-year tuition grant. Families may re-apply for the grant. It is the goal of the benefactors that parents and students will make a commitment to Catholic education beyond the term of the grant and that all those benefiting from the tuition grant will help sustain and grow opportunities for future generations of Catholic families.
