

Students who are absent (including those waiting for covid results):

- Students will be marked absent.
- Attendance to zoom or Google meet is optional, but students will be required to complete any work on their own and email teachers with questions, to be answered after 2:00-or as their teacher has requested from them.
- ~~Homework may be picked up after school, the same as previous absences.~~
- Work will not be scanned in throughout the school day.
 - The number of days absent will equal the number of days allowed to make up work upon returning to school.

Students who are quarantined or isolated (after receiving covid results or close contact notification):

- ~~Teachers will have 24 hours to gather the students' materials and scan in necessary items.~~
- ~~Parents will be notified when materials are ready to be picked up.~~
- Students' attendance to zoom or Google meet is **mandatory**: cameras must be on at all times.
- Students must be in a quiet, productive workplace at a table or desk. Pets, food, toys, and background distractions such as TV is considered unacceptable behavior.
- Materials for the day must be available for easy access. **BE ORGANIZED!**
- If a student cannot make it to a class, it is the student's responsibility to notify the teacher (parent notification is acceptable K-4).
- All work must be turned in ~~via electronically or dropped off by Friday at pick up time (unless a specific due date is noted by the teacher) or it will be considered late.~~ per the teacher's directives

Remote Learner Behavior Expectations:

- Students' cameras will be **on**.
- Students will be seated at a desk or table.
- Students will raise their hand to participate and verbally engage when a teacher is unable to see the student.
- Inappropriate behaviors will result in an orange slip with appropriate points given based on the offense.
